

## **Announcement of recruitment for foreign internship / visits / research mobility under the STER program**

Recruitment for foreign support begins on the day of publication of this announcement mobility of the best doctoral students from Poland and abroad (1 month or 2 months), pursuing education at a doctoral school at University of Warsaw.

### **Funded activity:**

The purpose of the trip is the participation of doctoral students in scientific, scientific and research internships/visits

training, undertaken for the purpose of conducting scientific research or obtaining knowledge and skills related to conducting scientific research in foreign units

scientific and scientific research.

### **The research stays must be completed by December 31, 2024.**

#### **Funding:**

As part of the support, selected PhD students will receive a lump sum benefit to cover their costs travel and living costs in a selected research center. They will also receive one-off development benefit\*.

Coverage of living costs in the amount of PLN 12,000\*\* per month or PLN 8,000 monthly\*\*\*.

Travel costs are covered in the form of a one-time lump sum

The straight-line distance between the participant's place of residence and the town stay (in km):

Flat rate amount per person:

below 500 km - PLN 1,000.00

between 500 - 999 km - PLN 2,000.00

between 1,000 – 2,999 km - PLN 3,000.00

between 3,000 – 6,000 km - PLN 4,000.00

over 5,000 km - PLN 5,000.00

\* For the purchase of e.g. raw materials, semi-finished products, reagents, access to laboratory rooms and large research infrastructure inaccessible (hard to access) in Poland, purchase of access to library collections, library card, etc.) in the amount of PLN 5,000 (non-obligatory).

\*\* In case of travel to OECD countries, as well as cities from non-OECD countries located in top 50 of the MERCER report.

\*\*\* for other countries not mentioned in the point above.

### **Submitting an application under the recruitment process**

The number of trips is limited. The candidates who will receive support are selected in continuous mode (on rolling-basis).

Recruitment lasts from the moment of announcement on the website of the Faculty of Law and Administration until announcement of the end of the recruitment process.

The application must be submitted on the form attached to the recruitment announcement with attachments indicated in the form to the e-mail address [ster@wpia.uw.edu.pl](mailto:ster@wpia.uw.edu.pl)

The application must be accompanied by confirmation of language knowledge, an individual research plan, confirmation of readiness for admission by the receiving entity and at least one letter recommendation.

Applications in the recruitment must be submitted in English.
